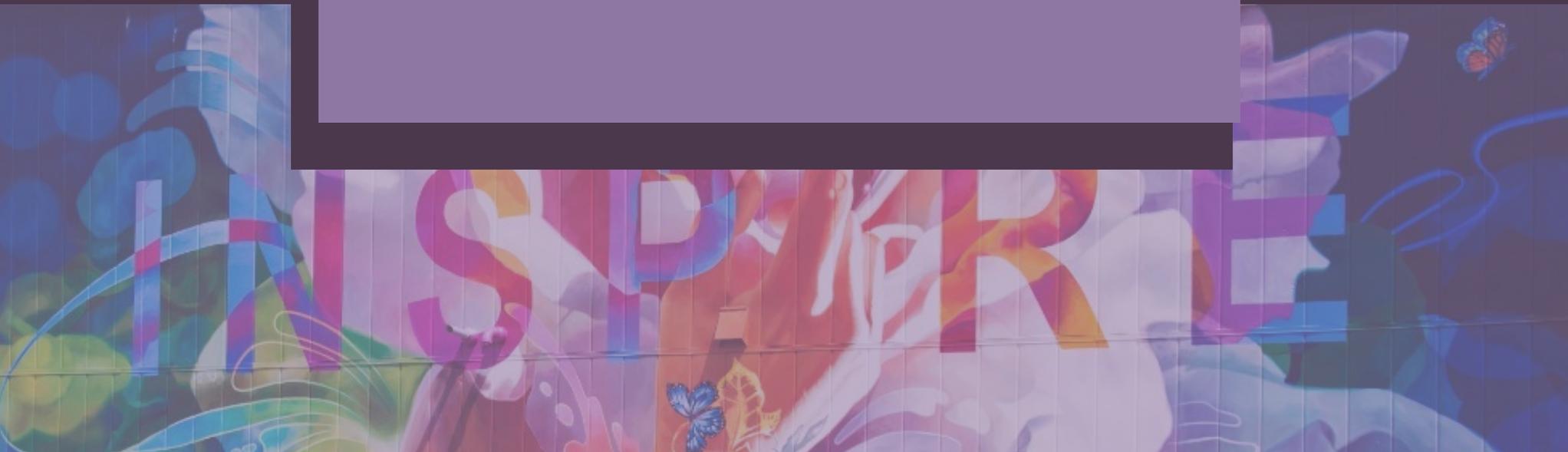

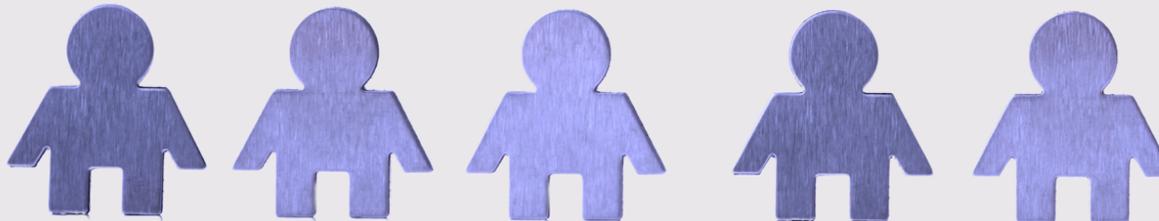




How to Turn a Follower into a Customer
