What Is the *One-Word* Strategy?

The One-Word Strategy is the practice of choosing a single intentional word to guide your year. It's not a slogan, resolution or trend. Your word becomes more of a strategic filter, grounding point, or a shared direction.

Your word helps you ask:

- Does this align with who we are?
- Does this decision move us toward what matters most?
- Are we building intentionally, or just staying busy?

One word can bring focus to leadership, consistency to brand, and alignment to growth. It's pretty incredible.



Why *One Word* Works (When Goals Alone Don't)

Goals are important, but goals without alignment can create overwhelm.

A single guiding word does what a dozen initiatives often can't:

It simplifies decisions

When everything feels urgent, your word helps you choose what's essential.

It strengthens brand consistency

Your word becomes a thread in how you communicate, show up, and serve.

It aligns teams around meaning

People don't rally around tasks. They rally around purpose.

It creates momentum with intention

Your year becomes shaped by clarity, not noise.



Choosing the *Right Word*: A Deeper Approach



The most effective word isn't the one that sounds inspiring. It's the one that reflects what you need most.

To choose wisely, consider these three questions:

1. How do we want this year to feel?

Not just what do you want to accomplish — but what tone do you want to lead with?

2. What quality do we want to guide every decision?

What would make this year more grounded, aligned, or impactful?

3. What do we want people to say about how we showed up?

At the end of the year, what word would you want your team, clients, or community to use?

Don't overthink it.

The right word often arrives with quiet clarity.



Turning *Your Word* Into a Strategy Tool

A word only works if you use it. Here are three ways to make your word actionable:

1. Use It as a Decision Filter Before saying yes, ask:

- Does this strengthen our mission?
- Does this reflect our values?
- Does this support the experience we want to create?
- Does this move us forward or simply keep us busy?

If it doesn't align, it may not belong.

2. Apply It to Your Brand Your word should shape how your brand feels in the world.

Ask:

- Does our messaging reflect this word?
- Does our client experience embody it?
- Does our content create connection and consistency?

Your brand is not just what you say — it's how people experience you.

3. Bring It Into Your Team Culture A word becomes powerful when it's shared.

Try introducing it in:

- team meetings
- quarterly planning
- onboarding
- client conversations
- celebration and reflection moments

When everyone knows the word, everyone knows the direction.
